

Bruno S. Frey – Short Biography

Bruno S. Frey was born in Basle, Switzerland in 1941. He studied Economics in Basle and Cambridge (England), and had a two year stay in the United States. Since 1969 he has been an Associate Professor of Economics at the University of Basle. He was Professor of Economics at the University of Constance between 1970-77, and since 1977 has been Professor of Economics at the University of Zurich. He is Editor of *Kyklos*, Research Director of CREMA-Centre for Research in Economics, Management and the Arts, and received an honorary doctorate in economics from the University of St. Gallen (Switzerland, 1998) and the University of Goeteborg (Sweden, 1998). He is a Fellow of the Public Choice Society 2005, a Distinguished Fellow of the Royal Society of Edinburgh (FRSE), 2005 and a Distinguished Fellow of CESifo Research Network, 2005. He is the author of numerous articles in professional journals, as well as the author of 20 books, some of which have been translated into nine languages.
